REGULATIONS REGARDING
HAWKERS, PEDDLERS AND VENDORS

Pursuant to New Hampshire RSA 31:102-a, the governing body at the Town of Hampstead hereby adopts the following ordinance, to become effective April 30, 1995:

During the time of any celebrative parade occurring within the Town of Hampstead, including but not limited to, Christmas parades, Memorial Day parades, and Fourth of July parades, any hawker, peddler, and vendor ("Vendor") wishing to sell their goods and services during the posted times of those parades:

1. Must submit not later than two (2) weeks prior to the scheduled parade date, a letter to the Board of Selectmen stating the name, address, telephone number of such *Vendor*, and the nature of the goods and services he or she intends to sell or offer, together with a check in the amount of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) as a license fee;
2. Shall be prohibited from hawking, peddling, or selling their goods and services along the published parade route during the times published for such parade; and
3. Shall, during the times published for such parade, be restricted to those areas as shall, from time to time, be designated by the Board of Selectmen before or by the Police Department during such parade.

Any *Vendor* violating this Ordinance shall be subject to immediate removal from the parade route and from those areas designated for *Vendors*, and shall be subject to a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
