The following ordinance was passed by ballot vote at the March 14, 2000 Annual Town Meeting:

ORDINANCE

No person shall wither be upon or remain upon or remain upon any public way or entry way to any public building in any manner which obstructs the reasonable and safe free passage of any other person, nor shall any person obstruct the free, convenient and safe use of any public sidewalk, street, highway, bridge, alley road or other passageway nor the entrance, corridor or passage of any public building by impeding, hindering, retarding, delaying, or otherwise restraining either pedestrian or motor vehicle traffic thereon or the passage thereof.

The work "person" shall include either one person or more than one person, whether as a pedestrian or while either the operator of or a passenger in a motor vehicle.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined upon conviction not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each offense. This ordinance shall not e deemed to prohibit or interfere with the freedom of lawful public assembly or the free expression of political speech or other free speech, provided those assembled do no and the speaker does not unreasonable intimidate, nor touch in any manner, nor harass, nor assault any other person in the exercise of such assembly or speech.

EFFECTIVE

This ordinance is in addition to all other ordinances heretofore adopted and shall become effective (i) sixty (60) days after its passage by the voters of Hampstead, or (ii) the passage of a constitutional amendment validating NH RSA 31:39-a whichever last occurs.
