



Hampstead's New Automated Trash & Recycling Collection

Beginning January 2019, Hampstead is moving to an automated curbside recycling and household waste pick-up system using wheeled carts.

Your new carts will be delivered by Pinard Waste Systems, our new household waste and recycling vendor, over the course of two weeks, beginning Monday, December 10th. Single residences will receive two 65-gallon carts, a blue cart for recyclables, and a gray cart for household waste. Multi-family units will receive the appropriate number of carts based on the current trash limits posted on Hampstead's website. Your carts will be delivered to the exact location they should be placed on pick-up days. Instructions will be included. Please note that carts are the property of the Town of Hampstead and are paired by serial number to each address. **Do not start using the carts until the week of December 31. Refer to the calendar below.**

Note- there is no change in pick-up days, all streets stay on the same pick-up schedule.



When Does Automated Collection Start for Me?

Hampstead's new automated collection program with Pinard Waste Systems begins Monday, December 31. Since Tuesday is a holiday (New Year's Day), there will be a one-day delay for some residents. This calendar outlines the adjusted collection schedule for the week of December 31, and the regular schedule that begins the week of January 7. Note – there is no change in pick-up days, all streets stay on the same pick-up schedule.

Important Recycling & Household Waste Information

Carts Delivered to Driveways Week of December 10

Starting December 10 (to December 23) carts will be delivered to driveways:

- Single-family residences will have one cart for household waste and one cart for recycling
- Multi-family residences will receive the right number of carts, according to household waste limit guidelines

Where Pinard places your cart on your driveway at delivery is where you need to place your carts each week to ensure the trucks can access the carts.

New Automated Recycling/Household Waste Pick-up Begins Dec. 31

Beginning December 31st, new carts must be placed curbside to ensure recycling/waste pick-up.

- Carts must be placed at the end of driveway (where Pinard initially delivered to) with lid opening facing street
- No plastic bags of any kind are allowed in the recycling carts.
- Both lids must be able to close.

- If an additional trash cart is needed, there is an **annual fee of \$150**.

- To swap your town-issued 65-gallon cart for a 35-gallon cart (that you would now own), it is a **one-time fee of \$75**.

Kent Farm Transfer Station

Visit the Town Hall to purchase transfer station stickers and dollar coupons for items with a fee.

Open 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on the following Saturdays in 2019 (2nd Sat of month) for BULK TRASH:

April 13, May 11, June 8, July 13, August 10, September 14, October 12, November 9

Open 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on the following Saturdays in 2019 for BRUSH & LEAVES only:

April 20, May 18, Oct. 19, Nov. 16

Transfer Station stickers required to access

Annual Sticker Fee: \$20.00/year

One-day Sticker Fee: \$20.00 for any size car/truck

PLUS a 1-time annual sticker purchase required

Curbside bulk item disposal is available for \$26 per item. To schedule collection and payment, residents may call Pinard Waste Systems at 1-800-675-7933. This service will be provided once per month.

Note: large items must be disassembled, and where applicable, drained of fluids, documented Freon Free

Allowable Disposal Items with Additional Fee:

Car & light pick-up truck tires (remove rims) \$4

Television/Monitors: up to 24 inches \$10 //

over 24 inches \$20 // Console TV \$30

Appliances containing Freon \$20

Mattresses & Box Springs: Crib & Twin: \$5/each

Full, Queen & King: \$10/each

Non-Allowable Disposal Items:

Hazardous wastes | Commercial Wastes | Shingles |

Treated or Manufactured Building Debris Residential

Refuse or Garbage

Holidays Delaying Recycling/Waste Pick-up One Day in 2019

Note: A one day trash pick-up delay occurs when a major holiday falls on a Monday through Thursday.

- Tuesday, January 1, New Year's Day
- Monday, May 27, Memorial Day
- Thursday July 4, Fourth of July
- Monday, September 2, Labor Day
- Thursday, November 28, Thanksgiving
- Wednesday, December 25, Christmas
- Wednesday, January 1, 2020, New Year's Day



“Can I Recycle This?” Know When It’s a **NO!**

ONLY the items listed below should go in your household recycling bin. If you’re unsure, don’t risk contaminating the load and place the item in the trash. This information is listed on your cart lid.



METAL

Food & Beverage Cans



GLASS

Bottles & Jars



PLASTIC

Bottles, Jars, Jugs, & Tubs



PAPER & CARDBOARD

Mixed Paper, Newspaper, Magazines, & Boxes

This is a picture of what not to do with your recycling cart. This cart includes many items that aren’t accepted and is bulging. Because of the plastic bags, pool tarp, aluminum siding, and broom, it will be considered trash, which result in surplus fees to the Town of Hampstead. You can do your part to eliminate these costs by keeping contamination out of recycling.

WHY DOES IT MATTER???

You may have seen in the news that new policies in China are impacting the recycling industry across the country, and right here in Hampstead.

In an effort to help the environment, too many of us are putting things into our recycling bins that should not be, HOPING they can be recycled. The result? Contaminated loads are being rejected at the processing center and disposed of as trash, resulting in charges to the Town.

To avoid these charges and ensure your items ARE recycled, please stick to the “acceptable items” list!
