

Single Stream Recycling Starts March 28, 2011

Instead of separating paper from plastic, glass, and aluminum, all recycling materials can now be placed in one recycling bin. In addition, Bestway now accepts all plastics marked 1-7, as well as the items listed below.

Simply combine all recyclable materials in your recycling bin – or a barrel of your own (35 gallons or under) that is clearly marked “RECYCLING.” *See a video on how Single Stream Recycling works at <http://www.ecomaine.org/mccordvideo.htm>*

The following is recyclable:

- All Plastics Marked 1-7
- Aluminum Cans
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Aluminum Foil (rinsed)
- Pots and Pans

All Types of Paper:

Brown Bags	Cardboard	Cardboard Boxes (broken down to 2' x 2')
Catalogs	Egg Cartons	Hard-Cover Books
Juice Boxes (remove straw)	Magazines	Junk Mail (windowed envelopes OK)
Newspaper	Office Paper	Paper Milk & Juice Cartons
Phone Books	Shoe Boxes	Soft-Cover Books
Paper Plates (remove food)	Pizza Boxes (remove wax liner and food)	

The following is NOT recyclable:

NO garbage	NO bubble wrap	NO window glass
NO hypodermic needles	NO food	NO packing peanuts
NO diapers	NO light bulbs	NO toys
NO sharp objects	NO potato chip bags	NO vinyl siding
NO napkins	NO paper towels	NO dirty paper plates
NO styrofoam (even with a recycling symbol)		NO plastic shopping bags (even with recycling symbol)
