Recycling & Trash Guidelines

Hampstead recycling is single stream, which means all recycling materials are placed in one recycling bin.

Running out of room in your bin? You can use any container, it just has to be clearly marked "Recycling" and our hauler will take it.

Please note: **do not put your recyclables in plastic bags, and do not put plastic bags in your recycling bins.** Plastic bags get tangled in the facility machinery, which can damage the equipment.

Weekly Curbside Trash Bag/Barrel Limits:

- Single family residents: Two 30-gallon barrels OR four 15-gallon trash bags OR two 30-gallon trash bags
- If you have more trash than these guidelines allow in a given week, you can purchase a sticker for each additional trash bag for \$2/bag. The sticker must be placed visibly on each additional bag and not on the trash barrel. Any additional trash bags outside of set limits without a sticker will not be picked up. Stickers are sold at Town Hall.

The following items are recyclable:

- All plastics marked 1 – 7
- Glass bottles and jars
- All types of paper, including catalogs, magazines, newspapers, phone books, books, brown bags, milk cartons, paper egg cartons, shoe boxes, cardboard boxes broken down to 2' x 2'
- Aluminum cans
- Junk Mail (windowed envelopes OK), grease-free pizza boxes (remove wax liner and food)
- PLEASE NOTE: You can recycle shredded paper curbside, but it MUST be placed in a paper bag that is sealed with tape or a staple. Please mark on the bag "Shredded Paper." If shredded paper is placed in your recycling bin in a plastic bag, it can't be recycled.

The following are not recyclable:

NO light bulbs, diapers, window glass, hypodermic needles, sharp objects, bubble wrap, toys, packing peanuts, vinyl siding, paper plates, napkins, pans, paper towels, plastic shopping bags, pots or styrofoam (even if it has a recycling symbol)

Note: A one day trash pick-up delay occurs when a major holiday falls on a Monday through Thursday.

- * Wednesday, July 4 (Fourth of July)
- * Monday, September 3 (Labor Day)
- * Thursday, Nov. 22 (Thanksgiving)
- * Tuesday, December 25 (Christmas)
- * Tuesday Jan. 1, 2019 (New Year's Day)

Kent Farm Transfer Station Schedule & Information

Open 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on the following Saturdays in 2018 (2nd Sat of month) for BULK TRASH:

April 14, May 12, June 9, July 14, August 11, September 8, October 13, November 10

Open 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on the following Saturdays in 2018 for BRUSH & LEAVES only:

April 21, May 19, Oct. 20, Nov. 17

Transfer Station Stickers are required to access the Kent Farm Transfer Station

Annual Sticker Fee: \$20.00/year

One-day Sticker Fee: \$20.00 for any size car/truck PLUS a 1-time annual sticker purchase required

Allowable Disposal Items:

Sofas | Chairs | Metal Items | Appliances | Electronics

Note: large items must be disassembled, and where applicable, drained of fluids, documented Freon Free

Allowable Disposal Items with Additional Fee:

Car & light pick-up truck tires (remove rims) \$4

Television/Monitors: up to 24 inches \$10 // over 24 inches \$20 // Console TV \$30

Appliances containing Freon \$20

Mattresses & Box Springs // Crib & Twin: \$5/each — Full, Queen & King: \$10/each

Non-Allowable Disposal Items:

Hazardous wastes | Commercial Wastes | Shingles | Treated or Manufactured Building Debris Residential Refuse or Garbage

Additional Disposal & Recycling Options in Hampstead

- Car Batteries, Used Oil, Thermostats, 20 lb & 30 lb Empty Propane Tanks
 - Accepted at the Town Garage, 35 Stage Rd, Open 8-1 the 1st & 3rd Saturday of each month
- Soft and Hard Cover Books in Good Condition [Note: You can recycle old/moldy books curbside]
 - Hampstead Library (Recent magazines accepted too)
- Clothing
 - In-season clothes accepted at the Hampstead Library for the Hollyhock Thrift Store
 - Container, Hannaford Parking Lot
 - Marion Garish Community Center, 39 West Broadway, Derry
 - Isaiah 58, 472 State Route 111, Hampstead, on FB (Isaiah58NH) or call (603) 952-8000 for info
 - Renew Calvary Church, on FB: (/renewfreeclothingcloset) or call 434-1516 for info
- Large Items (ie: furniture)
 - For \$15/item you can get these items picked up curbside. Purchase item disposal stickers at the Town Hall. Note - this does not include televisions/computers/monitors/ appliances.
 - Derry Transfer Station will take items for a fee. For information, call 603.432.4650 or visit www.derry.nh.us/Pages/DerryNH_Transfer/transfer.
- Plastic Shopping Bags can be recycled at Hannaford, Market Basket & Walmart
- Eye Glasses accepted at the Hampstead Library

NOTE: There are two Hazardous Waste Day events residents each year - one in spring and fall.
