Museum:

The copper caps have been completed and are awaiting installation, Rob met with a lighting specialist and went over a couple of options for new lighting fixtures however he felt that we should still look at other options in the hope of finding fixtures that would be more historical in appearance.

Meetinghouse:

Rob is still in the process of finding out if a window repair/restoration workshop is a possibility, so far, he has not found an interested party.

The board reviewed the rental agreement for the Meeting House and after some discussion a motion was made to keep the agreement as written with no changes. The motion was made by Chip and seconded by Joe. It was a unanimous decision in favor of keeping the agreement with no changes.

There was a discussion about the future use of the space adjacent to the Meeting House, there is a need for parking, however it needs to be constructed in a way that will be fitting for the location. Lyn suggested more of a park like setting with historically accurate plantings, John suggested that we should have a stone wall separating the area from the ballfield. It was agreed to meet with the police chief and the road agent to see what issues we may have with traffic on Emerson Ave.
