A cleaner open space solution, providing new parking spaces at a safer distance from the meetinghouse as well as some visual upgrades, including but not limited to, hardscaping, landscaping and stone wall. It will be presented as the most cost effective way to maintain open space consistent with the esthetic of the historic district, while offering a parking solution to Hampstead Green. Joe Passanise will be working to create an artist concept to aid in visualizing the end result. The deliberative session is scheduled for February 8th at 7 PM
