Under RSA 160 - C: 6, the Town of Hampstead's Governing Body requires a permit for display of permissible fireworks, which must be signed by the Police Chief (or designee) and the Fire Chief (or designee). A copy of the permit will be kept on file with the Town of Hampstead, and the original must be readily available upon request from either the Police Department or Fire Department. Permits will **NOT** be issued during a class 4 or class 5 Fire Danger Day as indicated by the State of New Hampshire.

You must be 21 years of age or older to possess or display permissible fireworks. Fireworks can only be displayed on private property; and with the written consent (or property owner is present) of the property owner.

At any time where permissible fireworks affects or compromises public safety, the Fire Chief or Police Chief or their designee may revoke the permit. Once the permit is revoked, permissible fireworks can no longer be displayed, and at the discretion of the Fire Chief or Police Chief, the permissible fireworks can be confiscated.
