It was noted that it would be good to have lights in the container and someone noted that there were LED portable lights like what you could use for camping.

T. Harrington reported that the new order on the trash/recycling containers are in and there should be 112 of each. She did report that the staff working that day for Buildings and Grounds and Highway had to unload the truck. We weren't told that the driver would not be assisting nor would there be a lift gate to get the containers off the truck.

T. Harrington also reported that there was a resident that needed to put in 50 hours of community service and one of the thoughts for a job was painting the container the dark gray. The committee thought that would be a good job and were okay with it.

Motion to adjourn at 8:00 pm was made by P. Wentworth and seconded by C. Cipriano and passed 3-0.
