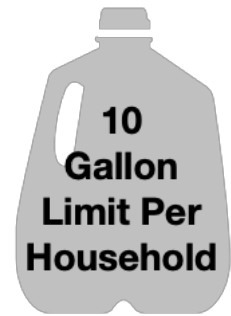

- ▶ Auto Repair Products
- ▶ Batteries (rechargeable)
Note: alkaline go in trash
- ▶ Car Fluids (Brake, Transmission)
- ▶ Chemicals (Pool, Photo)
- ▶ Cleaners (Bathroom, Drain, Oven, Tile)
- ▶ Degreasers
- ▶ Disinfectants
- ▶ Fluorescent Bulbs
- ▶ Garden Care (Chemical Fertilizer, Fungicides, Herbicides)
- ▶ Gasoline/Oil Mixtures
- ▶ Moth Balls
- ▶ Paint - Oil Based, Art
- ▶ Paint Thinner & Stripper
- ▶ Polish (Furniture, Metal)
- ▶ Propane Tanks (for Grills)
- ▶ Rat Poison
- ▶ Solvents

What is expected when I arrive?

Household Hazardous Waste Day: Saturday, October 24 - 9:00 am - 12:00 pm
Hampstead Middle School - 28 School St, Hampstead, NH

Site volunteers will be available if you have questions. You will be asked to participate in a short, anonymous survey while you wait. Specialized HHW staff will unload and sort your hazardous waste to ensure safety for all attendees.

Attendees must follow the following COVID-19 safety precautions:

1. Stay in your vehicle
2. Place your household hazardous waste in your car trunk or truck bed (not your backseat). Open your trunk when approaching the disposal team on site. Staff will then remove materials for safe disposal.
3. Do **not** bring containers you want back (e.g. fuel cans, plastic storage tubs). This will reduce the contact between attendees, staff and volunteers.
4. Wear a mask when near people and when vehicle window is down.

FAQ

Q: Can a business, school or municipality participate?

A: No, these collections are strictly for residential waste. You can call Tradebe, Inc. (800-388-7242) to discuss disposal options.

Q: How do I dispose of acrylic/latex paint?

A: Acrylic/latex paint must be dried fully then can be placed in your curbside trash. To dry out paint, mix with paint hardener powder (sold at hardware stores) or cat litter.
