PROOF OF RESIDENCY

The Town of Hampstead requires proof of residency before motor vehicle plates may be issued.

Upon request of the Town Clerk's office, you must provide a local utility bill in the applicant's name. The bill must be dated within the last 30 days, and the account current.

If you are a tenant, for an authorized place of residence, you may use a current lease agreement, or a rental receipt with your name, apartment name and complete address.

You may also provide proof of residency by presenting such other evidence that your domicile or abode is in Hampstead as the Town Clerk may accept.

If you are unable to provide proof of residency through the proper documentation, the owner of record for the address you are claiming, must sign the affidavit below and have it notarized.

The Town Clerk has the right to approve any and all motor vehicle applications.
